

Mariana gets new Kitchen Brazil Course

The technical qualification course will be offered by a Samarco, FIEMG and Mariana's City Hall partnership.

The Fiemg System, in partnership with Samarco and Mariana's City Hall, holds second round of the Kitchen Brazil course in the city. The action is free of charge and takes place from May 17th to 19th. It covers nutritious, healthy and low cost eating, also respecting regional differences. In the first course, held in February, about 150 people attended and approved the initiative.

Participants will learn how to take full advantage of foods. They will learn, for example, how to bake a cake using banana peel, besides learning how to reduce wastage and prepare meals while preserving flavor and nutrients.

Morning (from 8am to 11:20am) and afternoon classes (from 1pm to 4:20pm) will be held in the Mariana Convention Center (JK Square, S/N). On the completion of the course - which has the total duration of 10 hours and includes theoretical and practical skills - residents will receive the Kitchen Brazil book and certificate.
